



What is Special Education?

- Special education is programming designed to meet the unique educational needs of students with disabilities from birth through 21 years of age who meet the eligibility criteria under the law. It is defined as specialized instruction that meets the unique needs of a child with a disability. Services are provided at no cost to parent(s)/guardian(s)

- Accommodations, Modifications & Supports
- Participation in State & District-Wide Tests
- Positive Behavior Support Plan (if applicable)
